STANDARDS

Introductory lesson one - singing as a group/performing a steady beat with instruments

SYNOPSIS OF LESSON ACTIVITIES - "WHAT'S HAPPENING"

Students will start out the year hitting the ground running as opposed to sitting and listening to rules and regulations the whole time. Singing, playing instruments, and moving the whole time. They will be introduced to the idea of "WE ALL SING TOGETHER."

MATERIALS NEEDED

Classroom percussion instruments – drums, shakers, tambourines, woodblocks, etc.

INTRODUCTION/WARMUP


Students will find a seat – no specific seats this week. That will get settled next week. Introduce yourself and teach this intro song by rote:

"Welcome to the Music Room"



Students will sing with just voices, then standing, then marching, then patting, etc.

Students will then echo SOL/MI patterns in D major using their hands.



(Obviously switch out "Mr. B" for your name) You can do the entire group, select rows, and even individual singing.


REVIEW

NEW CONCEPT

Introduce the most important rule – "we all sing together." Whether we are sitting, standing, dancing, or playing instruments – we all sing together. If we do that, everything else is going to work. This includes anyone who comes in our room!

Introduce "The visitor song" – This is a song we can sing anytime someone knocks on our door to get them joining in the fun of "we all sing together."
